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HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 6003

Offered June 17, 2022

Amending and readopting House Joint Resolution No. 6001 of the 2022 Special Session I of the General Assembly of Virginia, pertaining to limiting legislation to be considered by such special session.

7 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That during the 2022 Special Session I of the General Assembly, summoned by proclamation of the Governor on March 23, 2022, commencing on April 4, 2022, except with the unanimous consent of the house in which the legislation 8 9 is offered, no bill, joint resolution, or resolution shall be offered or considered in either house during the 10 Special Session other than those relating to (i) conference reports continued from the 2022 Regular 11 Session, including H.B. 29 and H.B. 30; (ii) any such legislation as may be communicated from the 12 Governor; (iii) single-house commending and memorial resolutions; (iv) the rules of procedure or 13 14 schedule of business of the General Assembly or any of its committees; (v) the election of judges and 15 other officials subject to the election of the General Assembly; or (vi) appointments subject to the 16 confirmation of the General Assembly; or (vii) the protection and expansion of access to abortion care in Virginia in order to ensure the personal reproductive freedom of all Virginians; and, be it 17

RESOLVED FURTHER, That after the Special Session is convened for the first time, each body 18 19 may adjourn from time-to-time until reconvened with at least 48 hours' notice by the respective call of 20 the Speaker of the House of Delegates or the Chair of the Senate Committee on Rules; and, be it

21 RÉSOLVED FURTHER, That any conference committee on the Budget Bills shall complete its 22 deliberations and make the report of such conference available to the General Assembly as soon as 23 practicable. Neither house shall consider such conference report earlier than 48 hours after receipt, unless both houses respectively determine to proceed earlier by a vote of two-thirds of the members voting in 24 25 each house. No engrossment of the Budget Bills shall be required in either house, and any conference on the Budget Bills shall consider, as the basis of its deliberations, the Budget Bills as recommended by 26 27 the Governor and introduced in the House and the amendments thereto proposed by each house. A 28 report shall be issued concurrently with the report of the conference committee that identifies the 29 following by item number, narrative description, and dollar amount: (i) any nonstate agency 30 appropriation; (ii) any item in the conference report that was not included in a general appropriation bill 31 as passed by either the House or the Senate; and (iii) any item that represents legislation that failed in 32 either house during the regular or a special session; and, be it 33

RESOLVED FINALLY, That for purposes of this resolution:

34 "Budget Bill" means the general appropriation bill introduced in each house that authorizes the 35 biennial expenditure of public revenues for the period from July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2022, or July 36 1, 2022, through June 30, 2024.
