That § 59.1-514 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 11 § 59.1-514. Unwanted telephone solicitation calls prohibited. 12 13 A. No telephone solicitor shall initiate, or cause to be initiated, a telephone solicitation call to a 14 telephone number when a person at such telephone number previously has stated that he does not wish 15 to receive a telephone solicitation call made by or on behalf of the person on whose behalf the telephone solicitation call is being made. Such statement may be made to a telephone solicitor or to the 16 person on whose behalf the telephone solicitation call is being made if that person is different from the 17 telephone solicitor. For a telephone solicitation call via text message, such statement may be made by 18 19 responding to the text message with words such as "STOP," "UNSUBSCRIBE," or "OPT OUT" or 20 similar words indicating that the person does not want to receive such telephone solicitation calls. Any 21 such request not to receive telephone solicitation calls shall be honored for at least 10 years from the 22 time the request is made. 23 B. No telephone solicitor shall initiate, or cause to be initiated, a telephone solicitation call to a 24 telephone number on the National Do Not Call Registry maintained by the federal government pursuant 25 to the Telemarketing Sales Rule, 16 C.F.R. Part 310, and 47 C.F.R. § 64.1200. 26 C. It shall be an affirmative defense in any action brought under § 59.1-515 or 59.1-517 for a 27 violation of this section that the defendant has established and implemented, with due care, reasonable 28 practices and procedures to effectively prevent telephone solicitation calls in violation of this section, 29 including using in accordance with applicable federal regulations a version of the National Do Not Call 30 Registry obtained from the administrator of the registry no more than 31 days prior to the date any 31 telephone solicitation call is made. D. For purposes of this section, "telephone solicitation call" shall not include a telephone call made 32 33 to any person; (i) with that person's prior express invitation or permission as evidenced by a signed, written agreement stating that the person agrees to be contacted by or on behalf of a specific party and 34 35 including the telephone number to which the call may be placed, (ii) with whom the person on whose 36 behalf the telephone call is made has an established business relationship, or (iii) with whom the 37 telephone solicitor making the telephone call has a personal relationship. The exemption for an 38 established business relationship or a personal relationship shall not apply when the person called 39 previously has stated that he does not wish to receive telephone solicitation calls as provided in 40 subsection A.
