6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 18.2-130.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to peeping or spying into a
7	dwelling or occupied building by electronic device; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 18.2-130.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 18.2-130.1. Peeping or spying into dwelling or occupied building by electronic device; penalty.
11	It is unlawful for any person to knowingly and intentionally cause an electronic device to enter the
12	property of another to secretly or furtively peep or spy or attempt to peep or spy into or through a
13	window, door, or other aperture of any building, structure, or other enclosure occupied or intended for
14	occupancy as a dwelling, whether or not such building, structure, or enclosure is permanently situated or
15	transportable and whether or not such occupancy is permanent or temporary, or to do the same, without
16	just cause, upon property owned by him and leased or rented to another under circumstances that would
17	violate the occupant's reasonable expectation of privacy. A violation of this section is a Class 1

17 violate the occupant's reasonable expectation of privacy. A violation of this section is a18 misdemeanor. The provisions of this section shall not apply to a lawful criminal investigation.
