0 7	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Article 1.4 of Chapter 13 of Title 22.1 a section
	numbered 22.1-212.27:1, relating to virtual school programs; virtual through-year growth assessment
8	administration.
9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 1.4 of Chapter 13 of Title 22.1 a
11	section numbered 22.1-212.27:1, as follows:
12	§ 22.1-212.27:1. Virtual school programs; virtual through-year growth assessment administration.
13	Any student enrolled in a virtual school program, as defined in § 22.1-212.23, may take any
14	through-year growth assessment required pursuant to subsection C of § 22.1-253.13:3 in a virtual
15	setting that best meets the educational needs of the student, subject to the following conditions:
16	1. The student takes the assessment on an assigned date and at an assigned time;
17	2. The student attends a synchronous assessment session initiated and managed by virtual school
18	program personnel;
19	3. If the assessment platform does not allow integrated camera proctoring, the student shall use two
20	devices for the duration of the assessment administration: one device on which the student takes the
21	assessment and a second device on which an assessment proctor monitors for the duration of the
22	assessment administration via the camera on the second device. However, if the assessment platform
23	allows for the proctor to view the student and background, then a second device shall not be required;
24	4. The device on which the student takes the assessment has browser lockdown software in operation
25	for the duration of the assessment administration to eliminate the possibility of Internet browser usage
26	on such device for the duration of the assessment administration;
27	5. The device on which the student is being monitored has audio capabilities accessible by the
28	assessment administrator;
29	6. An adult approved in accordance with the terms of the virtual school program, such as the
30	student's parent, is physically present with the student for the duration of the assessment administration;
31	7. The virtual school program seeks to maintain a student assessment taker to assessment proctor
32	ratio of 10 to one or lower;
33	8. The student does not exit the assessment administration until instructed to do so by the assigned
34	assessment proctor; and
35	9. Assessment submission is verified by the assessment administrator.
