| 15 | A. Any person who, with the intent of interfering with, obstructing, or impeding the administration of |

| 17 | witness, court officer, or court employee, of any court of the Commonwealth or any other state, the |
| 18 | District of Columbia, or the United States or any territory thereof, pickets or parades in or near a |
| 19 | residence occupied or used by such judge, juror, witness, court officer, or court employee, or any |
| 20 | immediate family member of such judge, juror, witness, court officer, or court employee, or with such |
