12	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 32.1-283.9 as follows:
13	§ 32.1-283.9. Investigation of deaths involving Sudden Unexpected Death in Epilepsy; protocol;
14	information; training.
15	A. For purposes of this section, "Sudden Unexpected Death in Epilepsy" or "SUDEP" means the
16	sudden and unexplained death of a healthy individual with epilepsy that is not by drowning, injury, or
17	other known causes.
18	B. In any case involving a finding of death resulting from SUDEP, the Office of the Chief Medical
19	Examiner (i) shall, in addition to other information it deems appropriate, indicate SUDEP as the cause
20	of death on the decedent's death certificate and (ii) shall within 30 days of such finding refer the case to
21 22	the Epilepsy Foundation of Virginia, which shall provide to the decedent's next of kin, if known,
22 23	information regarding the benefits of and process for submitting the deceased's medical information, including information about the deceased's history of epilepsy and seizures, to the North American
