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11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 53.1-2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
13	§ 53.1-2. Appointment of members; qualifications; terms and vacancies.
14	There shall be a State Board of Local and Regional Jails, which shall consist of nine 11 residents of
15	the Commonwealth appointed by the Governor and subject to confirmation by the General Assembly. In
16	making appointments, the Governor shall endeavor to select appointees of such qualifications and
17 18	experience that the membership of the Board shall include persons suitably qualified to consider and act upon the various matters under the Board's jurisdiction. Members of the Board shall be appointed as
10 19	follows: (i) one former sheriff Θ_r ; (ii) one former warden, superintendent, administrator, or operations
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20 21	manager of a state or local correctional regional jail facility; (ii) (iii) one individual two individuals
21	manager of a state or local correctional regional jail facility; (ii) (iii) one individual two individuals employed by a public mental health services agency with training in or clinical, managerial, or other

management or performing audit investigations; (vii) (viii) one citizen member who represents community interests; and (viii) (ix) two individuals with experience in conducting criminal, civil, or 27 28 29 30 death investigations. Members of the Board shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor and shall be appointed for terms

31 of four years. A vacancy other than by expiration of a term shall be filled by the Governor for the 32 unexpired term. 33

No person shall be eligible to serve more than two full consecutive four-year terms.
