2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 18.2-308.07 of the Code of Virginia, relating to concealed handgun*  
3 *permits; Virginia Criminal Information Network; disclosure of information.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 18.2-308.07 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**8 **§ 18.2-308.07. Entry of information into the Virginia Criminal Information Network.**

9 A. An order issuing a concealed handgun permit pursuant to § 18.2-308.04, or the copy of the permit  
10 application certified by the clerk as a de facto permit pursuant to § 18.2-308.05, shall be provided to the  
11 State Police and the law-enforcement agencies of the county or city by the clerk of the court. The State  
12 Police shall enter the permittee's name and description in the Virginia Criminal Information Network so  
13 that the permit's existence and current status will be made known to law-enforcement personnel  
14 accessing the Network for investigative purposes.

15 B. The Department of State Police shall enter the name and description of a person issued a  
16 nonresident permit pursuant to § 18.2-308.06 in the Virginia Criminal Information Network so that the  
17 permit's existence and current status are known to law-enforcement personnel accessing the Network for  
18 investigative purposes.

19 C. The State Police shall withhold from public disclosure permittee information submitted to the  
20 State Police for purposes of entry into the Virginia Criminal Information Network, except that such  
21 information shall not be withheld from any law-enforcement agency, officer, or authorized agent thereof  
22 acting in the performance of official law-enforcement duties *when such information is related to an*  
23 *ongoing criminal investigation or prosecution*, nor shall such information be withheld from an entity that  
24 has a valid contract with any local, state, or federal law-enforcement agency for the purpose of  
25 performing official duties of the law-enforcement agency *when such information is related to an*  
26 *ongoing criminal investigation or prosecution*. However, nothing in this subsection shall be construed to  
27 prohibit the release of (i) records by the State Police concerning permits issued to nonresidents of the  
28 Commonwealth pursuant to § 18.2-308.06 or (ii) statistical summaries, abstracts, or other records  
29 containing information in an aggregate form that does not identify any individual permittees.
