9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. § 1. The Department of Conservation and Recreation (the Department), shall establish a two-year
12	pilot program beginning October 1, 2023, and ending September 30, 2025, to enhance accessibility for
13	individuals with limited mobility in Virginia's state parks by providing all-terrain power wheelchairs that
14	may be used by such persons during their visits.
15	§ 2. The Department shall choose the locations for the pilot program and shall enter into a contract
16	for the purchase of all-terrain power wheelchairs for the pilot program. Such wheelchairs shall be
17	equipped with tank-like tracks capable of traveling up hills, over rocks, roots, streams, and sand;
18	clearing fallen trees; plowing through tall grass; and tackling uphill climbs. The Department may
19	establish guidelines to administer the pilot program.
20	§ 3. By November 1, 2025, the Department shall report the outcomes of the pilot program to the
21	Chairmen of the House Committee on Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources and the Senate
22	Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources. Such report shall include the cost of
23 24	the entire program, any benefits attendant to the placement of all-terrain power wheelchairs in the locations of the pilot program, and recommendations concerning the continued placement of all-terrain
24 25	power wheelchairs in Virginia's state parks.
