That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 32.1-175.2 as follows: 11 § 32.1-175.2. Notification of water contamination to waterworks customers. 12 A. For the purposes of this section, "PFAS chemicals" means a class of fluorinated organic 13 chemicals containing at least one fully fluorinated carbon atom, also referred to as perfluoroalkyl and 14 15 polyfluoroalkyl substances. B. Upon receiving results from a water quality analysis, a waterworks owner shall notify customers 16 when (i) PFAS chemicals are present in the water supply or (ii) a contaminant in the water supply 17 exceeds the maximum contaminant level established in the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations 18 (40 C.F.R. Part 141) or the maximum contaminant level established by the Board in regulations, 19 20 whichever is more stringent. Such notification shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation 21 in the affected areas within 10 business days of the waterworks owner receiving results from a water 22 quality analysis and mailed to all customers via the United States Postal Service within five business 23 days of the waterworks owner receiving results from a water quality analysis. Such published and 24 mailed notifications shall include: 25 1. The date that a sample was taken for the water quality analysis and the date that the waterworks 26 owner received the results of such water quality analysis; 27 2. The name of the contaminant or contaminants and the amount of the contaminant or contaminants 28 as it relates to the maximum contaminant levels in subsection B: 29 3. Information regarding potential adverse health impacts and populations that may be at an 30 increased risk of potential adverse health impacts as a result of exposure to the contaminant or 31 contaminants; 4. Actions that the waterworks owner has taken, is taking, or will take to reduce the level of the 32
