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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 15.2-1127 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 15.2-1127. Vacant building registration; civil penalty.
13	The Town of Clifton Forge, the Town of Pulaski, in a conservation and rehabilitation district of the
14	town, the Town of Timberville, and any city, by ordinance, may require the owner or owners of
15	buildings that have been vacant for a continuous period of 12 months or more, and which meet the
16	definition of "derelict building" under § 15.2-907.1, to register such buildings on an annual basis and
17	may impose an annual registration fee not to exceed \$100 \$500 to defray the cost of processing such
18	registration. The registration of buildings shall be on forms designated by the locality and filed with the
19	agency designated by the locality. Failure to register shall be a \$200 \$500 civil penalty for the first
20	violation and a \$2,000 civil penalty for any subsequent violations; however, failure to register in
21	conservation and rehabilitation districts designated by the governing body, or in other areas designated
22	as blighted pursuant to § 36-49.1:1, shall be punishable by a civil penalty not exceeding \$400 \$1,000 for
23	the first violation and \$4,000 for any subsequent violations. Notice shall be mailed to the owner or

owners, at the address to which property tax notices are sent, at least 30 days prior to the assessment of
the civil penalty.
