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VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend and reenact § 10.1-1801.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to Open-Space Lands 3 Preservation Trust Fund; use of funds; conservation easements to nonprofit land trust.

6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

7 1. That § 10.1-1801.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 8

§ 10.1-1801.1. Open-Space Lands Preservation Trust Fund.

9 A. The Foundation shall establish, administer, manage, including the creation of reserves, and make 10 expenditures and allocations from a special nonreverting fund in the state treasury to be known as the Open-Space Lands Preservation Trust Fund, hereinafter referred to as the Fund. The Foundation shall 11 12 establish and administer the Fund solely for the purpose of providing grants in accordance with this section to localities acquiring fee simple title or other rights, interests, or privileges in property, to 13 localities for persons conveying conservation easements to nonprofit land trusts, or to persons conveying 14 15 to the Foundation fee simple title or other rights, interests, or privileges in property on agricultural, forestal, or other open-space land pursuant to the Open-Space Land Act (§ 10.1-1700 et seq.) and, if 16 17 applicable, the Virginia Conservation Easement Act (§ 10.1-1009 et seq.).

B. The Fund shall consist of general fund moneys, gifts, endowments or grants from the United 18 19 States government, its agencies and instrumentalities, and funds from any other available sources, public 20 or private.

21 C. Any moneys remaining in the Fund at the end of a biennium shall remain in the Fund, and shall 22 not revert to the general fund. Interest earned on moneys received by the Fund shall remain in the Fund 23 and be credited to it.

24 D. The purpose of grants made from the Fund shall be to aid (i) localities acquiring fee simple title 25 or other rights, interests, or privileges in property Θ_{τ} ; (ii) persons conveying to the Foundation fee 26 simple title or other rights, interests, or privileges in property with; or (iii) localities to provide funding 27 for projects approved by the Foundation to persons conveying conservation easements to nonprofit land trusts so long as such easement has a local coholder. Such grants may be used for the costs associated 28 29 with the conveyance of the property interest, which may include legal costs, appraisal costs, or all or 30 part of the value of the property interest. In cases where a grant is used to purchase all or part of the 31 value of a property interest, moneys from the Fund may also be used by the Foundation to pay for an 32 appraisal, provided that the appraisal is the only appraisal paid for by the Foundation in the acquisition 33 of a particular property interest. To be eligible for a grant award, the property interest shall be (a)34 compliant with the Open-Space Land Act (§ 10.1-1700 et seq.) or (b) a conservation easement under the Virginia Conservation Easement Act (§ 10.1-1009 et seq.), so long as the holder of such easement is 35 accredited by the Land Trust Accreditation Commission or its designated subsidiary entity at the time of 36 37 the grant award. If the Land Trust Accreditation Commission accreditation is not available at the time 38 of the grant application for such holder under clause (b), the Foundation shall evaluate such holder on 39 a case-by-case basis consistent with its established guidelines. For the purposes of this subsection, 40 "local coholder" means the governing body of the locality in which the easement is located, a public 41 recreational facilities authority, any other local entity authorized by statute to hold open-space 42 easements, or a soil and water conservation district, if authorized to hold an easement under the 43 **Open-Space** Land Act.

44 E. The Foundation shall establish guidelines for submittal and evaluation of grant applications. In 45 evaluating grant applications, the Foundation may give priority to applications that:

1. Request a grant to pay only legal and appraisal fees for a property interest that is being donated 46 47 by the landowner;

48 2. Request a grant to pay costs associated with conveying a property interest on a family-owned or 49 family-operated farm; or 50

3. Demonstrate the applicant's financial need for a grant.

51 F. No open-space land for which a grant has been awarded under this section shall be converted or 52 diverted from open-space land use unless: 53

1. Such conversion or diversion is in compliance with subsection A of 10.1-1704; and

54 2. Any open-space easement on the land substituted for land subject to an easement with respect to 55 which a grant has been made under this section meets the eligibility requirements of this section.

56 G. Up to \$100,000 per year of any interest generated by the Fund may be used for the Foundation's **SB1122ER**

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57 administrative expenses.
