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11 As used in this chapter, unless the context or subject matter requires otherwise, the following words 12 or terms shall have the *a different* meaning herein ascribed to them, respectively:

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14 "Building" means a combination of any materials, whether portable or fixed, having a roof to form a structure for the use or occupancy by persons or property. The word "building" shall be construed as 15 though followed by the words "or part or parts thereof" unless the context clearly requires a different 16 meaning. "Building" does not include roadway tunnels and bridges owned by the Department of 17 18 Transportation, which shall be governed by construction and design standards approved by the 19

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"Building Code" means the Uniform Statewide Building Code and building regulations adopted and 21 22

23 "Code provisions" means the provisions of the Uniform Statewide Building Code as adopted and 24 promulgated by the Board, and the amendments thereof as adopted and promulgated by such Board from 25

26 "Building regulations" means any law, rule, resolution, regulation, ordinance, or code, general or 27 special, or compilation thereof, heretofore or hereafter enacted or adopted by the Commonwealth or any 28 county or municipality, including departments, boards, bureaus, commissions, or other agencies thereof 29 of such state or local governments, relating to construction, reconstruction, alteration, conversion, repair, maintenance, or use of structures and buildings and installation of equipment therein. The term "Building 30 31 regulations" does not include zoning ordinances or other land use controls that do not affect the manner 32 of construction or materials to be used in the erection, alteration, or repair of a building or structure.

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57 "Local building department" means the agency or agencies of any local governing body charged with 58 the administration, supervision, or enforcement of the Building Code and regulations, approval of plans, 59 inspection of buildings, or issuance of permits, licenses, certificates, or similar documents.

"Local governing body" means the governing body of any county, city, or town in the 60 61 Commonwealth.

62 "Municipality" means any city or town in the Commonwealth.

63 "Owner" means the owner or owners of the freehold of the premises or lesser estate therein, a 64 mortgagee or vendee in possession, assignee of rents, receiver, executor, trustee, or lessee in control of 65 a building or structure.

"Review Board" means the State Building Code Technical Review Board. 66

67 "State agency" means any state department, board, bureau, commission, or agency, or other unit of 68 this state government in the Commonwealth.

69 "Building" means a combination of any materials, whether portable or fixed, having a roof to form a structure for the use or occupancy by persons, or property. The word "building" shall be construed as 70 though followed by the words "or part or parts thereof" unless the context clearly requires a different 71 meaning. "Building" shall not include roadway tunnels and bridges owned by the Department of 72 Transportation, which shall be governed by construction and design standards approved by the 73 74 Commonwealth Transportation Board.

75 "Equipment" means plumbing, heating, electrical, ventilating, air-conditioning and refrigeration 76 equipment, elevators, dumbwaiters, escalators, and other mechanical additions or installations.

88 6. Implementation of best management practices associated with farm operations.

89 "Construction" means the construction, reconstruction, alteration, repair or conversion of buildings 90 and structures.

91 "Owner" means the owner or owners of the freehold of the premises or lesser estate therein, a 92 mortgagee or vendee in possession, assignee of rents, receiver, executor, trustee, or lessee in control of a 93 building or structure.

94 "Director" means the Director of the Department of Housing and Community Development.

95 "Stop work order" means a legally binding written order to immediately cease work on a building or structure that (i) is issued by a local building official to a property owner, the property owner's agent, 96 or the person performing the work; (ii) identifies the specific violations of the Building Code in regard 97 to the work being performed; and (iii) states the conditions under which such work may be resumed. 98

99 "Structure" means an assembly of materials forming a construction for occupancy or use, including stadiums, gospel and circus tents, reviewing stands, platforms, stagings, observation towers, radio towers, 100 water tanks, underground and aboveground storage tanks (underground and aboveground), trestles, piers, 101 wharves, swimming pools, amusement devices, storage bins, and other structures of this general nature 102 103 but excluding water wells. The word "structure" shall be construed as though followed by the words "or 104 part or parts thereof" unless the context clearly requires a different meaning. "Structure" shall does not include roadway tunnels and bridges owned by the Department of Transportation, which shall be 105 governed by construction and design standards approved by the Commonwealth Transportation Board. 106 107

"Department" means the Department of Housing and Community Development.

§ 36-114.1. Appeals of Review Board decisions related to stop work orders. 108

109 If, during an appeal pursuant to the provisions of the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.) of the Review Board's decision with respect to the issuance of a stop work order by a local building 110 official, the court finds in favor of the party that was issued the stop work order, such party shall be 111 entitled to recover its actual costs of litigation, including court costs, attorney fees, and witness fees, 112 from the locality responsible for issuing the stop work order. 113

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
