That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 17 of Title 45.2 an article numbered 9, consisting of a section numbered 45.2-1734, as follows: 11 12 13 Article 9. 14 Virginia Power Innovation Fund and Program. 15 § 45.2-1734. Virginia Power Innovation Fund and Program. A. There is hereby created in the state treasury a special nonreverting fund to be known as the 16 Virginia Power Innovation Fund, referred to in this section as "the Fund," that shall be administered by 17 the Department. The Fund shall be established on the books of the Comptroller. All amounts 18 appropriated and such other funds as may be made available to the fund from any other source, public 19 20 or private, shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to the Fund. Interest earned on moneys in 21 the Fund shall remain in the Fund and be credited to it. Any moneys remaining in the Fund, including 22 interest thereon, at the end of each fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund but shall remain in 23 the Fund. Moneys in the Fund shall be used solely for the purposes of research and development of 24 innovative energy technologies, including nuclear, hydrogen, carbon capture and utilization, and energy 25 storage. Expenditures and disbursements from the Fund shall be made by the State Treasurer on 26 warrants issued by the Comptroller upon written request signed by the Director. 27 B. The Virginia Power Innovation Program is hereby established for the purpose of (i) establishing a 28 Virginia nuclear innovation hub from such funds as may be available from the Fund and (ii) awarding 29 grants on a competitive basis from such funds as may be available from the Fund to support energy 30 innovation. The Program shall be administered by the Department. In administering the Program, the 31 Department shall, in collaboration with the Virginia Nuclear Energy Consortium, establish and publish guidelines and criteria for disbursement deployment of funds pursuant to clause (i), including providing 32 33 grants to support higher education research on advanced nuclear technologies and advanced reactor 34 technologies, to fund nuclear energy workforce development programming, and to assist with site 35

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selection for future small modular reactor projects in Virginia. In administering the Program, the 36 Department shall, in collaboration with the Secretary of Commerce and Trade, establish and publish guidelines and criteria for disbursement of funds pursuant to clause (ii). The Department shall oversee each grant awarded through the Program and ensure thorough reporting on each such grant.
