11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Title 22.1 a chapter numbered 27, consisting
13	of sections numbered 22.1-369 through 22.1-372, as follows:
14	CHAPTER 27.
15	SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, MATHEMATICS, AND COMPUTING (STEM+C)
16	COMPETITION TEAM GRANT PROGRAM AND FUND.
17	§ 22.1-369. Definitions.
18	As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning:
19	"Fund" means the STEM+C Competition Team Grant Fund established in § 22.1-371.
20	"Qualified school" means a public elementary or secondary school in the Commonwealth at which at
2 1	least 60 percent of students qualify for free or reduced lunch.
22	"STEM+C" means science, technology, engineering, mathematics, and computing.
$\overline{23}$	"Computing" means computer science, computational thinking, and computer coding.
24	"STEM+C competition team" means an extracurricular team-building activity that has a primary
25	objective of engaging students in STEM+C-related activities and may include participating in
26	project-based team competitions.
27	§ 22.1-370. STEM+C Competition Team Grant Program created; purpose.
28	The STEM+C Competition Team Grant Program is established to encourage interest in
29	STEM+C-related subject areas and support STEM+C extracurricular team-building activities in public
30	schools in the Commonwealth by providing grants to qualified schools for use in establishing or
31	supporting STEM+C competition teams.
32	\$ 22.1-371. STEM+C Competition Team Grant Fund established.
33	There is hereby created in the state treasury a special nonreverting fund to be known as the
34	STEM+C Competition Team Grant Fund, referred to in this section as "the Fund." The Fund shall be
35	established on the books of the Comptroller. All funds as may be available from public or private
36	sources shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to the Fund. Interest earned on moneys in the
37	Fund shall remain in the Fund and be credited to it. Any moneys remaining in the Fund, including
38	interest thereon, at the end of each fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund but shall remain in
39	the Fund. Moneys in the Fund shall be used solely for the purpose of providing grants to qualified
40	schools for use in establishing or supporting STEM+C competition teams. Expenditures and
41	disbursements from the Fund shall be made by the State Treasurer on warrants issued by the
42	Comptroller upon written request signed by the Superintendent.
43	§ 22.1-372. Board to develop and issue grant guidelines; application; administration.
44	A. The Board shall develop and issue guidelines for the general requirements of qualifying for a
45	grant from the Fund and shall develop the grant application form. Such guidelines shall be exempt from
46	the provisions of the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.).
47	B. Beginning January 1, 2024, qualified schools may apply for a grant from the Fund. Grants from
48	the Fund awarded to each qualified school shall not exceed \$10,000 per school year and shall be
49	designated to establish or support STEM+C competition teams. Grants shall be issued in the order that
50	each completed eligible application is received. In the event that the amount of eligible grants requested
51	in a fiscal year exceeds the funds available in the Fund, such grants shall be paid in the next fiscal year
52	in which funds are available.
