4. Title: Diabetes; distribution of hypodermic needles, syringes, and insulin pens for treatment.

Summary: Provides that the regulation of persons acting as medical equipment suppliers and restrictions on the distribution of hypodermic needles and syringes do not prohibit the dispensing or distribution of hypodermic needles, syringes, or insulin pens by persons authorized to dispense insulin for the treatment of diabetes.
