**4. Title:** Public schools; codes of student conduct; policies and procedures prohibiting bullying.

**5. Summary:** Requires each local school board to require the principal of each public school to notify the parent of any student who is the victim in an alleged bullying incident of the alleged incident within 24 hours of when the allegation was made. The bill also clarifies that the principal of each public school is required to notify the parent of any student who is not the victim but is otherwise involved in an alleged bullying incident of the status of any investigation within five school days of the allegation of bullying.
