The bill also repeals statutes requiring the Department to report annually on its pollution prevention activities and to publish the Virginia Toxic Release Inventory each year, as well as a statute requiring the chairman of the Virginia Roanoke River Basin Advisory Committee to submit an annual executive summary of the interim activity and work of the committee.
