The Tobacco Indemnification and Community Revitalization Fund is a part of the state treasury; as such, a nongeneral fund budget amendment may be provided at a later date

The Virginia Tobacco Region Revolving Fund, which provides loans to local governments, is administered by Tobacco Region Revitalization Commission, in conjunction with the Virginia Resources Authority, and is not a part of the state treasury. A budget amendment is not required should the number of eligible projects increase for this Fund.
