- 4. Title: Prescription for controlled substance; practitioner-patient relationship.
- **5. Summary:** Allows a practitioner to establish a bona fide practitioner-patient relationship for the purpose of prescribing a Schedule VI controlled substance if the patient chooses not to seek reimbursement by a health plan or carrier for the prescribing and if such prescribing complies with federal requirements for the practice of telemedicine. This bill contains a reporting requirement.
