**3. Committee:** Passed both Houses.

**4. Title:** Medical marijuana program; product, registration, dispensing, and recordkeeping requirements.

**5. Summary:** Amends and adds numerous provisions regarding the Commonwealth's medical marijuana program, including provisions related to recordkeeping, product registration, expiration dates, allowable deviations, dispensing, packaging, labeling, and advertising. The bill requires pharmaceutical processors and cannabis dispensing facilities to collect and provide to the Board of Pharmacy by July 1, 2024, data regarding implementation of the bill. The bill also requires the Board of Pharmacy to make certain amendments to its regulations.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Minimal.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This legislation, as amended, would have a minimal fiscal impact on the Department of Health Professions. Any costs to amend regulations can be handled within existing resources.
