4. Title: Public institutions of higher education and certain other public educational institutions.

5. Summary: Prohibits any prospective or current full-time or part-time employee of a public institution of higher education or any of its centers or other subdivisions; the Virginia Commonwealth University Health System Authority; Eastern Virginia Medical School; or any authority, center, or institute specified by the bill that enrolls or otherwise provides instruction to students from being required, as a condition of initial or continued employment, to be immunized against COVID-19. The bill also prohibits any prospective or current full-time or part-time student at any such institution, authority, center, institute, or school from being required, as a condition of initial or continued enrollment, to be immunized against COVID-19.
