4. Title: Pregnant inmates; coverage through state plan for medical assistance

5. Summary: The substitute bill directs the Department of Medical Assistance Services, in coordination with the Department of Corrections, to identify pregnant incarcerated persons in the custody of state correctional facilities who are enrolled in or may be eligible for services under the Commonwealth's program of medical assistance and ensure that those persons released on medical furlough for the purpose of giving birth or other pregnancy-related care understand the steps necessary to obtain coverage for such care prior to the medical furlough.
