3. Committee: Passed both Houses

4. Title: Loans for septic systems.

5. Summary: Authorizes the State Water Control Board to provide loans from the Virginia Water Facilities Revolving Fund to a local government for the purpose of correcting onsite sewage disposal problems (small water facility projects) to protect or improve water quality and prevent the pollution of state waters. The bill allows loan funding for repairs or upgrades to onsite sewage systems that are owned by eligible businesses, defined in the bill, where public health or water quality concerns are present and connection to a public sewer system is not feasible because of location or cost.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that any fiscal impact on the Department of Environmental Quality as a result of this bill can be absorbed within existing resources.
