3. Committee: Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources

4. Title: Loans for septic systems.

5. Summary: Authorizes the State Water Control Board to provide loans from the Virginia Water Facilities Revolving Fund to a local government for the purpose of correcting problems in onsite sewage disposal systems owned by eligible businesses or individual citizens. Sets parameters for eligibility, including location within a locality that is in the Rural Coastal Virginia Community Enhancement Authority, as defined in § 15.2-7600. Eligible businesses include certain bed-and-breakfast operations, campgrounds, restaurants, and businesses that use working waterfronts.
