2. **Patron:** Krizek

3. **Committee:** Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources

4. **Title:** Consultation with federally recognized Tribal Nations in the Commonwealth; permits.

5. **Summary:** Requires the Department of Conservation and Recreation, the Department of Environmental Quality, the Department of Historic Resources, and the Virginia Marine Resources Commission to establish policies and procedures for consulting with federally recognized Tribal Nations in the Commonwealth when evaluating certain permits and reviews relating to environmental, cultural, or historic resources that potentially impact those federally recognized Tribal Nations in the Commonwealth. The bill directs the Secretary of the Commonwealth to designate an Ombudsman for Tribal Consultation to facilitate communication and consultation with federally recognized Tribal Nations in the Commonwealth. The bill codifies Executive Order 82 (2021).

8. **Fiscal Implications:** *This revised fiscal impact statement reflects updated information regarding the bill's impact to the Secretary of the Commonwealth.*

The Departments of Environmental Quality, Conservation and Recreation, Historic Resources, Transportation and Aviation, as well as the State Corporation Commission, and the Marine Resources Commission, anticipate that any costs associated with this bill can be absorbed within current resources. The Secretary of the Commonwealth anticipates that a Tribal Ombudsman position will be needed, for \$160,250.
