**4. Title:**    Juvenile justice; human trafficking screening.

Summary:** Requires juvenile and circuit courts and the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) to include trauma-informed screening measures to identify whether the juvenile has been a victim of human trafficking and determine appropriate treatment and service options when they make a physical and mental examination of children within the court's jurisdiction or committed to DJJ by the courts.
