Summary:** Establishes the Advisory Council on Sickle Cell Disease to advise the Commissioner on the efforts to improve awareness of sickle cell disease and the needs of individuals with sickle cell disease. 8. Fiscal Implications: The provisions of this legislation would have a fiscal impact on the Virginia Department of Health (VDH). The bill establishes the Advisory Council on Sickle Cell Disease to advise the Commissioner on the efforts to improve awareness of sickle cell disease and the needs of individuals with sickle cell disease. VDH shall provide staff support and board member compensation. VDH will need to contract the services of a part-time coordinator to accomplish tasks outlined in the bill. The coordinator will be responsible for communicating with the Governor's office, convening and facilitating Advisory Council meetings, providing support and feedback to Advisory Council members, and drafting the annual report due to the Governor and General Assembly by the established due date. The total estimated contract cost is \$31,075 annually. Additional costs associated with this position include annual VITA/telecom (\$4,290) charges and office supplies (\$500).

Additional costs associated with implementation of this bill include travel reimbursement costs for Advisory Council participants (\$1,736), lunch (\$512), and lodging (4,060). These estimates assume that the council would meet four times a year, therefore cost estimates are scalable depending how often the council meets. The total cost estimate to meet the provisions of the bill is \$42,173 annually.
