- **4.** Title: Plans and programs; drought evaluation and response plans; Potomac River.
- **5. Summary:** Requires the State Water Control Board to recognize service areas for water utilities in the Commonwealth that use the Potomac River as a water supply source as a distinct drought evaluation region. The bill requires the Board to incorporate certain provisions from the Metropolitan Washington Water Supply and Drought Awareness Response Plan: Potomac River System into the existing drought evaluation plans that are applicable to the Potomac River drought evaluation region; as well as in comprehensive water supply planning process; state, regional, and local water supply plans.
