3. **Committee:** Committee Referral Pending

4. **Title:** Treatment services for sexual assault survivors; emergency contraception; provision by health care.

5. **Summary:** Requires the State Board of Health to adopt regulations that provide for the administration of emergency contraception by health care providers to survivors of sexual assault if the survivor requests it. The bill modifies the Criminal Injuries Compensation Fund so that it pays for such emergency contraception.

6. **Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

7. **Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Final.

8. **Fiscal Implications:** The Workers' Compensation Commission states that the bill may increase the number of Sexual Assault Forensic Exam (SAFE) claims filed with the Commission, but it is difficult to quantify the increase in claims. The provisions of this legislation would not have a fiscal impact on the Virginia Department of Health, the Department of Human Resource Management, or the State Corporation Commission.
