Summary:** Clarifies the duty of all agencies, as defined in the bill, and political subdivisions of the Commonwealth and certain other entities to cooperate with and assist the Behavioral Health Commission in the performance of its duties and requires such agencies, political subdivisions, and other entities to, upon request, provide to the Commission certain information and facility access. The bill also excludes from the mandatory disclosure provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act records of the Commission.
