Also requires any animal testing facility operated by an institution of higher education in the Commonwealth that receives a citation for critical noncompliance under the Animal Welfare Act, as defined in the bill, to notify institutional leadership. Exempts any federal facilities or privately owned licensed veterinary practices.
