3. Committee: Health, Welfare and Institutions

4. Title: Prescriptions; telemedicine; refusal to fill prescription from telemedicine provider; prohibition.

5. Summary: Prohibits pharmacies and pharmacists from refusing to fill prescriptions solely on the basis of a prescriber's use of a telemedicine platform to provide services. A pharmacist shall not prioritize dispensing a prescription from a prescriber who does not use telemedicine over dispensing a prescription from a prescriber who does use telemedicine solely on the basis of the prescriber's use of a telemedicine platform to provide services.
