3. Committee: Health, Welfare and Institutions

4. Title: Emergency medical services; hospitals; mandatory reporting of controlled substance overdoses.

5. Summary: Requires emergency medical services agencies and providers and hospitals to report incidents where a person is treated and released in response to a suspected or actual controlled substance overdose. The bill requires reporting to the Department of Health through an established overdose mapping program within 120 hours of the incident.
