**4. Title:** Purchase of firearms; special identification without a photograph.

**5. Summary:** Provides that to establish personal identification and residence in Virginia for the purposes of purchasing a firearm, a prospective purchaser may present a special identification card without a photograph issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles to a person with a sincerely held religious belief prohibiting the taking of a photograph.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) already issues non-photo identification for individuals with religious exceptions, so the agency does not anticipate a fiscal impact on its operations as a result of this proposal.
