3. Committee: Education and Health

4. Title: Department of Education; Standards of Learning assessment revision work group; timeline.

5. Summary: Prohibits the Department of Education from releasing a Request for Proposal for a provider of revised Virginia Standards of Learning summative assessments of proficiency until after the work group convened for the purpose of developing a plan for the implementation of such revised assessments has submitted its initial iteration of such plan. The bill also permits the Department to extend the current state assessment contract until December 31, 2025, to ensure continuity in the administration of the state assessment program.

8. Fiscal Implications: There is no anticipated state fiscal impact resulting from the provisions of this bill.
