3. Committee: Education and Health

4. Title: Virginia-based nonprofit organizations; schools for adults to earn credentials.

5. Summary: Requires the Department of Education to authorize a Virginia-based nonprofit organization as a local education agency to provide schools for adults to earn (i) (a) an industry-recognized credential or (b) dual college credit and (ii) a high school diploma on one or more diploma pathways set forth in the relevant Board of Education regulation in which enrollment is open, on a space-available basis, to adults who reside throughout the Commonwealth.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Education can absorb any additional responsibilities associated with this bill within existing resources.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Education

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No

11. Other Comments: It is unclear whether a nonprofit organization can be classified as a local education agency. DOE would need to consult with the Office of the Attorney General. This bill is identical to HB1729.
