Summary: Requires the governing board of each public institution of higher education to adopt policies and procedures requiring the release to each student or, if such student is a dependent, the parent of each student enrolled at such institution of an itemized list of how such student's individual annual tuition and other mandatory fees are allocated, including the exact amount of such student's tuition and mandatory fees that are used to subsidize financial aid grants and scholarships for other students at such institution. The bill requires such policies and procedures to include a provision allowing any student or the parent of any student to opt out of receiving such itemized list.

8.	Fiscal Implications: The fiscal impact is indeterminate at this time. All institutions do not track how tuition, fees, general funds, and other educational & general (E&G) revenue all amalgamate to fund the E&G budget. Costs may include modifications to student information data systems for additional disaggregation of data, necessary mailing requirements, dissemination of itemized data to all students and parents, and management of compliance with the opt-out options presented by this bill.
