3. Committee: Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources

4. Title: Permit for coal ash landfill storage; proximity to a private well prohibited.

5. Summary: Prohibits the approval of any new permit for a coal ash storage facility in Planning District 8 if such facility is located within one mile of an existing residential area that is not served by municipal water supply, unless the owner or operator has offered to provide municipal water supply service for such residential area and any requested service connections for residential properties in existence at the time such permit application is filed. Any such offer is required to be made in writing to any resident located within one mile of the facility boundary and in coordination with the municipal water supply service.
