4. Title: Wetlands; exemption for federal government agencies.

Summary: Makes it a requirement for the Marine Resources Commission to, in conjunction with local wetlands boards and other affected state and federal agencies, develop administrative procedures to expedite the processing of applications for certain habitat permits; and develop administrative procedures to expedite processing from agencies of the United States government, including any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States.
