4. Title: Emergency medical services agencies; ordinances or resolutions; designation as emergency response.

5. Summary: Requires that ordinances or resolutions establishing an emergency medical services agency shall specify the geographic boundaries of the agency's primary service area within the locality. This bill also directs that emergency medical services agencies that respond to medical emergencies be a designated emergency response agency and be recognized as an integral part of the official public safety program of the locality with responsibility for providing emergency medical response.
