4. **Title:** Maternal Mortality Review Team; annual compilation and release of statistical data.

5. **Summary:** Requires the Maternal Mortality Review Team to annually compile statistical data and make such data available to the Governor, General Assembly, and the public. Currently, the Maternal Mortality Review Team is required to compile and release such data on a triennial basis.

8. **Fiscal Implications:** The provisions of this legislation would have a fiscal impact on the Virginia Department of Health. This bill would require the Maternal Mortality Review Team (MMRT) to compile and release statistical data from a triennial basis to an annual basis. VDH does not have sufficient resources to handle the increase in workload required from this legislation. VDH would need general fund support to a wage employee with experience in Epidemiology or Biostatistics to support the data collection, data cleaning, analysis and development of the report that now will be required annually. The wage employee would also assist the MMRT facilitation and record collection activities, which are necessary to do the data work and report. Total costs for a wage employee would be \$51,875.
