3. Committee: Education and Health

4. Title: Public elementary and secondary schools; threat assessment team members; training requirement.

5. Summary: Requires each local school board to work with its local law enforcement agency to conduct an annual threat assessment to determine potential risks and threats for each school within the locality. The bill also requires new threat assessment team members established at each public elementary and secondary school to complete initial threat assessment training and all threat assessment team members to complete refresher training every three years.
