4. Title: Department of Veterans Services; hyperbaric oxygen therapy; data collection.

- 5. Summary: Allows the Department of Veterans Services to contract with any hospital in the Commonwealth that furnishes the treatment option of hyperbaric oxygen therapy to provide hyperbaric oxygen therapy to any veteran in the Commonwealth who has been certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs or any branch of the United States Armed Forces as having post-traumatic stress disorder or traumatic brain injury. The Department must include in any contract with such hospital to furnish hyperbaric oxygen therapy the requirement that data be collected to assess the efficacy of hyperbaric oxygen therapy for veterans and any other information deemed relevant by the Department.

- **8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Department of Veterans Services (DVS), this proposal is beyond the scope of what the agency currently offers and would require additional resources to provide such services. As such, the fiscal impact on the agency operations cannot be determined at this time.
