**4. Title:** Evaluation and qualification of retired circuit court and district court judges

**5. Summary:** The substitute bill amends § 16.1-69.22:1 (Temporary recall of retired district court judges; evaluation) and § 17.1-106 (Temporary recall of retired judges; evaluation) to establish that no retired judge is authorized or eligible for recall if such judge, prior to submitting a notice of retirement, sought reelection to a subsequent term but was not reelected by a majority of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly.
