The bill also eliminates the consideration of certain factors as a requirement for the Commissioner when recording applications for transfers or assignments.

8.	Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will have an indeterminate and negligible revenue impact on the Marine Resources Commission (MRC). According to MRC, transfer fees are deposited into the Oyster Leasing, Conservation, and Repletion Programs Fund. On average, MRC processes four transfers per year.
