**4. Title:**    Office of Data Governance and Analytics; Chief Data Officer.

**5. Summary:** Repeals the provision enacted in 2021 that would sunset the Office of Data Governance and Analytics (ODGA) and the Commonwealth Data Trust effective July 1, 2023. The bill also requires that ODGA be responsible for overseeing and supporting any workforce development data systems authorized under the Secretary of Labor to ensure the interoperability of the systems, to facilitate data sharing, to identify innovative technology solutions, and to support processes that create data-informed decisions.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary - No state fiscal impact.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** SB800 assumes the continuation of ODGA in fiscal year 2024, therefore no budget amendment is required. ODGA does not anticipate a fiscal impact from the other provisions in this legislation.

**10. Technical Amendment Necessary:** No.

**11. Other Comments:** HB1591-H1 extends, but does not repeal, the sunset clause for ODGA.
