3. Committee: Passed the Senate

4. Title: Oyster Replenishment Fund; oyster resource user fees to be credited to Fund.

5. Summary: Adds gifts, donations, grants, bequests, and other funds to the list of revenues that may be deposited into the Oyster Replenishment Fund (the Fund), along with user fees. Provides that the Fund may be used for replenishment projects including recycling. Allows moneys in the Fund to be used to encourage donations of oyster shells for oyster replenishment projects.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that any fiscal impact on the Marine Resources Commission as a result of this bill can be absorbed within existing resources.
