10 11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-56.3 as follows: § 18.2-56.3. Firearm locking device required for sale or transfer of handgun; child safety warning
12	required; penalty.
13 14	A. As used in this section, "locking device" means (i) a device that if installed on a firearm and
15	secured by means of a key or a mechanically, electronically, or electromechanically operated
16	combination lock prevents the firearm from being discharged without first deactivating or removing the
17	device by means of a key or mechanically, electronically, or electromechanically operated combination
18	lock or (ii) a locking mechanism incorporated into the design of a firearm that prevents discharge of the
19	firearm by any person who does not have access to the key or other device designed to unlock the
20	mechanism and thereby allow discharge of the firearm.
21	B. Except as provided in subsection C, it is unlawful for any licensed manufacturer, licensed
22	importer, or licensed dealer to sell, deliver, or transfer any handgun to any person, other than a
23	licensed manufacturer, licensed importer, or licensed dealer, unless the transferee is provided with a
24	locking device for that handgun and the handgun is accompanied by the following warning, which shall
25	appear in conspicuous and legible type in capital letters and printed on a label affixed to the gun and
26	on a separate sheet of paper included within the packaging enclosing the handgun: THE USE OF A
27	LOCKING DEVICE OR SAFETY LOCK IS ONLY ONE ASPECT OF RESPONSIBLE FIREARM
28	STORAGE. FIREARMS SHOULD BE STORED UNLOADED AND LOCKED IN A LOCATION THAT IS
29	BOTH SEPARATE FROM THEIR AMMUNITION AND INACCESSIBLE TO CHILDREN. FAILURE TO
30	PROPERLY LOCK AND STORE YOUR FIREARM MAY RESULT IN CIVIL OR CRIMINAL LIABILITY.
31	C. This section does not apply to (i) the manufacture for, transfer to, or possession by the
32	Commonwealth or the United States or a department or agency of the Commonwealth or the United
33	States of a handgun or (ii) the transfer to or possession by a law-enforcement officer employed by an

at entity referred to in clause (i) of a handgun for law-enforcement purposes.
D. A violation of this section is punishable as a Class 1 misdemeanor.
