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#### VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Article 1 of Chapter 11 of Title 10.1 a section 3 numbered 10.1-1103.1, relating to Department of Forestry; Forestland and Urban Tree Canopy 4 Conservation Plan required.

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## Approved

#### 7 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

8 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 1 of Chapter 11 of Title 10.1 a 9 section numbered 10.1-1103.1 as follows: 10

## § 10.1-1103.1. Forestland and Urban Tree Canopy Conservation Plan.

11 A. The Department shall establish a Forestland and Urban Tree Canopy Conservation Plan (the 12 Plan) to conserve the Commonwealth's forestland and incentivize the protection of forests and other 13 similar sensitive natural areas as an integral part of state forestry planning and the local comprehensive planning process. The Plan shall be reviewed by the Board of Forestry. In developing the Plan, the 14 15 Department shall include elements determined by the State Forester, including the following:

1. Examine the current status and trends of forests and tree canopies in the Commonwealth;

16 2. Identify challenges to forest health, forestland, and tree canopy conservation efforts, including 17 18 land use, climate change, and invasive species and other challenges identified by the stakeholder group; 19 3. Identify priority forests for conservation emphasizing protection of streams or wetlands, areas with 20 steep slopes or highly erodible soils, wildlife corridors, and large contiguous blocks of forest;

4. Develop forest-related and tree canopy-related goals;

22 5. Identify current and potential funding streams and state and local entities that will be vital to 23 achieve forest and tree canopy conservation goals; and

24 6. Ensure consistency with the objectives of the Board of Forestry with respect to forest management, 25 including forest protection, management, and replacement.

26 B. The Plan, reviewed by the Board of Forestry, shall be developed in coordination with a Technical 27 Advisory Committee that shall include representatives from the Department of Environmental Quality, 28 Department of Wildlife Resources, Department of Conservation and Recreation, agricultural and forestry 29 industries, environmental and conservation organizations, local governments, the Virginia Cooperative 30 Extension, professional environmental technical experts, residential and commercial development 31 industries, and other stakeholders as the Department deems appropriate.

32 C. The Department shall update the Plan at least once every five years and shall reconvene the 33 Technical Advisory Committee and seek input prior to approval of any updates to the Plan. The 34 Department shall hold a 30-day public comment period on the Plan and any subsequent updates to the Plan. Following any such update, the Plan shall be made available on its website and submitted to the 35 Governor and the Chairmen of the House Committee on Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources 36 37 and the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources.

38 2. That the initial Forestland and Urban Tree Canopy Conservation Plan required by 39 § 10.1-1103.1 of the Code of Virginia, as created by this act, shall be established by November 1, 40 2026. The Department of Forestry shall post the Plan on its website and submit the Plan to the 41 Governor and the Chairmen of the House Committee on Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural 42 Resources and the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources no later
